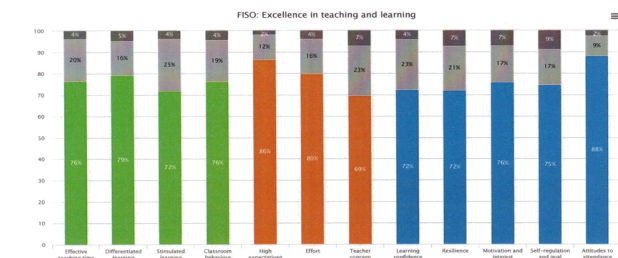
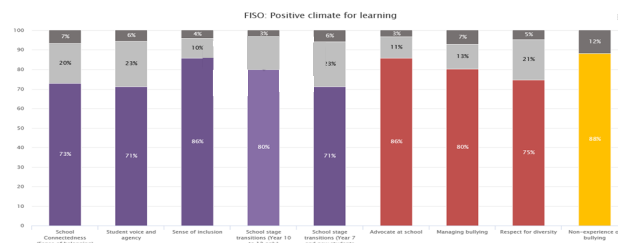

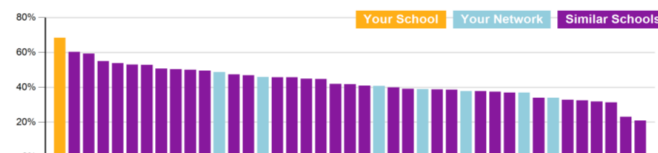
Kindergarten students have their own modern facilities and also have access to college facilities such as the gymnasium and library on a regular basis.



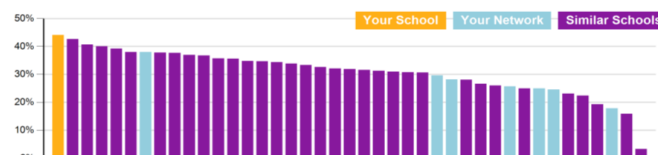

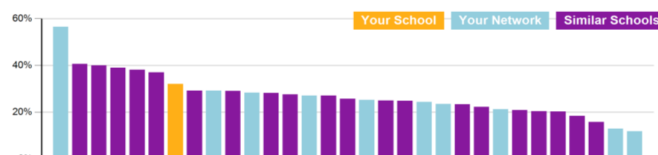
Year 3 Reading trend 2012-2016
The 4 year trend NAPLAN data.



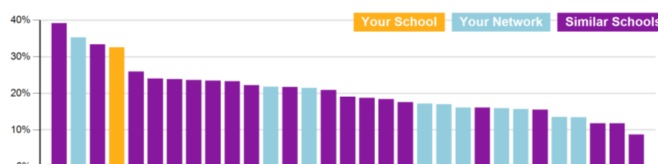
Year 5 Reading trend 2012-2016

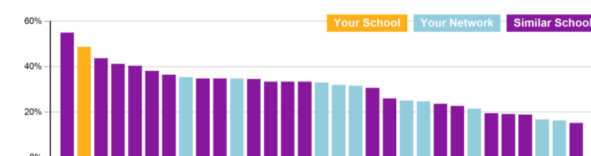


Year 9 Reading trend 2012-2016

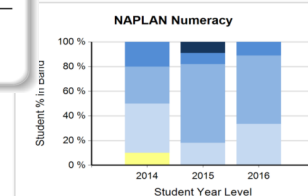
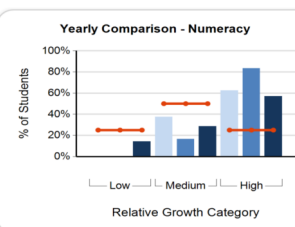
